

Hillsboro City Council Meeting
November 10, 2020
Public Hearing

Acting Mayor Duncan called the meeting to order at 6:45 pm.

Roll call was taken and those present were Acting Mayor Duncan and Commissioners Downs, Murphy and Robbins. Commissioner Murphy and Acting Mayor Duncan joined remotely.

The "Pledge of Allegiance" was recited.

Acting Mayor Duncan explained the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposed strategic plan for the City and rezoning of the Eagle Zinc property now owned by the City.

There were no public comments.

Acting Mayor Duncan explained that Community Planner Jonathan Weyer had completed the strategic plan and the public hearing was the last step in approving the plan. Weyer said it was a long process that took several people to complete and he thanked everyone that helped work on the plan for the City. Weyer said the plan is not something set in stone but a general direction the City would like to go in that can be changed at anytime. Duncan asked anyone in attendance if they had any questions or comments and there were no public comments or questions about the strategic plan.

Acting Mayor Duncan explained there were two parcels both which would be annexed into corporate city limits. The PIN numbers for both parcels are 16-01-476-002 and 16-12-201-001. Duncan asked anyone in attendance if they had questions or comments there were no public comments or questions about the rezoning from R1 to I1. Commissioner Downs asked why there were two parcels and he was told the property is split into two parcels.

Motion to adjourn the hearing was made by Commissioner Robbins and seconded by Commissioner Downs to adjourn at 7:02 pm. Motion carried 4-0.
