

**Hillsboro City Council Meeting
April 14, 2020**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Roll call was taken and those present were Mayor Sullivan and Commissioners Downs, Murphy, Duncan and Robbins.

The "Pledge of Allegiance" was recited.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Public comment:

Gene Knisley addressed the Council on liquor license extensions and asked how many façade grants could be obtained per business. Mayor Sullivan said City liquor licenses should be renewed as usual and if the state doesn't open up the City will then issue a rebate to businesses that were not able to open up and use their license. Mayor Sullivan said the rebate would be \$50 a month. Mayor Sullivan said a business may apply for one façade grant per address per year. Commissioner Duncan asked about businesses that are selling alcohol outside but not inside and Mayor Sullivan said the City could track that and City could rebate minus the days they were open.

Motion was made by Commissioner Duncan and seconded by Commissioner Robbins to approve paying bills for the month of April in the amount of \$353,540.17. Motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Sullivan a NV.

Motion was made by Commissioner Robbins and seconded by Commissioner Duncan to approve a \$2,000 façade grant reimbursement to Tony Marcolini for the garage door at the Opera House. Motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Sullivan a NV.

Motion was made by Commissioner Robbins and seconded by Commissioner Downs to approve purchasing fireworks from Extreme Pyrotechnics. After discussion a **Motion was made by Commissioner Murphy** and seconded by Commissioner Robbins to table agenda item no. 8 the purchase of fireworks from Extreme Pyrotechnics. Motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Sullivan a NV.

Motion was made by Commissioner Robbins and seconded by Commissioner Downs to approve a bid from Stutz Excavating for the Rountree St. / Summer St. intersection project for the amount of \$187,812.32. Motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Sullivan a NV.

Motion was made by Commissioner Robbins and seconded by Commissioner Downs to adopt Resolution No. 2020-02 a supplemental resolution for the Rountree St. / Summer St. intersection project appropriating \$217,000 from the MFT fund for the project. Motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Sullivan a NV.

Motion to Adjourn was made at 7:39 pm by Commissioner Robbins and seconded by Commissioner Downs. Motion carried 4-0 with Mayor Sullivan a NV.
