

## **BRUSH DROP OFF AND PICKUP**

With the increasing workload due to mandates on the water system and focusing on making repairs to city infrastructure the Street Department will no longer be able to collect brush piles and large limbs except for storm debris as outlined below. Pickup is a courtesy the city provides and may be postponed or stopped at any time.

## **GUIDELINES FOR BRUSH AND LEAF PICKUP**

To ensure your branches and leaves are picked up, take the following steps to set them out correctly:

- All items must be in paper bags
- Bags must be in the boulevard in front of the residence.
- If you are using disposable containers, they must weigh less than 60 pounds.
- **NO** plastic bags will be picked up.
- Bags will be picked up 1 or 2 times a month when time allows.
- City crews will make only one pass down each street.

## **STORM & EMERGENCY PICKUP**

After storms or other emergencies, as determined by the Street Superintendent or his designee, the Street Department may schedule additional pick-ups. These will be posted on city social media accounts.

## **BRUSH AND LEAF DROP-OFF**

Loose yard waste, tree branches and yard waste in paper bags may be taken to the city burn pile at 722 City Lake Rd Monday-Friday during the hours of 7 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. from Labor Day to Memorial Day and 6 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. from

**Memorial Day to Labor Day. No plastic bags, trash or dimensional lumber may be dumped.**

**No tree service, landscaper or individual for hire may dispose of yard waste at the burn pile.**
