AREA ATTRACTIONS

Orpheum Theatre

This local family owned theatre features new releases and matinees both for the very low admission price of \$8 and that includes your popcorn and soda! Best movie deal in Illinois! The Orpheum is famous for delivering the ultimate movie experience.

Bremer Sanctuary

Home of the Hickory Hills Chapter of the Illinois Audubon Society. Bremer Sanctuary is 203 acres of protected area and homes to scores of birds and animals in Montgomery County, walking trails as well as an education center and showplace for natural areas restoration. Open every day of the year from dawn to dusk. Located just north of Hillsboro.

Hillsboro Sports Complex

4 lighted fields, 1 unlighted field, 1 batting cage, 3 soccer fields, 6 tennis courts, concession areas, picnic pavilions and a children's play area.

Central Park Pool

This public pool was first constructed in 1937 by WPA workers and offers a family friendly spot to take a dip and cool off on those hot summer days. Central Park Pool is traditionally open from Memorial Day through the 2nd week in August. Admission is only \$3 and concessions are available.

Opera House Brewery

The Opera House, on the southeast corner of Main and Wood Streets, was built in 1887 on the site of the former American House tavern and hotel. The American House was a widely known and well patronized tavern, which provided food and lodging for travelers, including Stephen Douglas and Abraham Lincoln. In May of 2017, Tony and Jennifer Marcolini purchased the Opera House and began extensive renovations and created Opera House Brewing Company, Hillsboro's first brewery in over 120 years.

Hillsboro Summer Concert Series

Held on the stage at 4th of July Point the first Friday of each month June through September featuring seasoned touring acts, these free outdoor concerts are family friendly. Light food available. Olde Tyme Tractor Show


Held in July at Lake Hillsboro Park. Antique tractors, kids games, kiddie tractor pull, parades and food.
